Fiscal Improvement Plan

Commitment to transparency and fiscal responsibility - Develop and maintain a five-year plan that specifies actions necessary to improve the city's financial position, including debt reduction, capital investments, revenue growth, and expense reduction.

Improving Economic Development Efforts

Focus on job creation - Tipton will achieve successful job creation projects by leveraging existing industries and capitalizing on successful efforts in nearby counties. These will require short- and long-term economic development planning to ensure consistency. This will include partnering with the Tipton County Chamber of Commerce to improve business retention and expansion, workforce development investments, and support local investment in our community.

This will include supporting leadership development, supporting Accelerate(765), and continuing the City's Facade Program to encourage local investment in the City of Tipton.

This will help each department head to create long-term funding strategies, with the help of the City's financial consultants, for all of the major projects or equipment needed to improve the City of Tipton.
